Agenda Item 4 - Report: Friends of Tempe Public Library

• Larry Conway, Friends of the Tempe Public Library (Friends) President, announced that the donation drop box at the front of the library will be replaced with ones with rollers

- L. Conway informed the Tempe Public Library (Library) Board that there is a new member on the Friends of the Library Board
 - Ginny Sylvester has been with the Arizona State University Library for 37 years, volunteers at the Tempe Arts Center and currently is with the Friends of the Tempe Public Library Bookstore
- L. Conway stated that through October 2023, the Friends of the Tempe Public Library contributed \$23,222 to the Tempe Public Library

Agenda Item 5 - Staff Report: Jessica Jupitus, Deputy Community Services Director

- Jill Brenner, Librarian II+, gave an update specific to the planning of the Library's 2024 FanCon event;
 - 84 exhibitors are scheduled to attend;
 - Four (4) food trucks are booked for the event;
 - There will be a FanCon Fun Factory this year where the Library's Youth Division and Playmobile will have activities for kids including inflatable axe throwing and a rockclimbing wall;
 - There are programs hosted at the Tempe Public Library leading up to FanCon to get patrons excited for FanCon 2024
- Jessica Jupitus, Deputy Community Services Director Library Services Division, gave the following report specific to Tempe Public Library operations:
 - o 305 adults were engaged in programming during November 2023; programs included:

- December programming is focused on FanCon to get patrons excited for the event with cosplay construction, comic creation, and more!
- J. Jupitus reported the following information specific to operations of Tempe Public Library's (Library) Youth and Teen Services areas:
 - 969 participants were engaged in **youth programming** during Novmeber 2023, J.
 Jupitus highlighted the following programs:

• Storytime:

- Kids Café (Mondays, Tuesday, and Thursdays, 12 sessions)
- Open Learning Lab (daily)
- Totally Tween Hangouts (Fridays, Two (2) sessions)
- Get Inked (alternating Saturdays, two (2) sessions)
- Math Mania, (Tuesdays, four (4) sessions)
- 47 Youth Activity Kits and 72 teen STEAM kits were checked-out for in-library use;
- 98 participants were engaged in **Teen Programming** during November 2023; J. Jupitus highlighted the following programs:
 - Game On (Wednesdays, five (5) sessions)
 - Life Skills Mondays (Mondays, four (4) sessions)
 - Create Thursday (Thursdays, four (4) sessions)
 - Teen-Led Dungeons and Dragons (Saturdays, two (2) sessions)
 - Makers Lab (Wednesdays, four (4) sessions)
 - Tabletop Kingdom (Sundays, four (4) sessions)
 - Teen Volunteers provided 88.5 hours of service among 22 teens
- The Youth Librarians are working on weeding and updating the youth non-fiction collection to ensure our patrons get accurate information in the books they check out
- A National Honor Society Group approached the library to host a "Read Me" event with 17 teens reading to younger children
- Physical circulation of materials decreased in November 2023;
 - Physical circulation of materials in November 2023 totaled 40,885 uses;

- Physical circulation of materials in November 2022 totaled 40,932 uses;
- Physical circulation of materials in October 2023 totaled 46,978 uses;
- o Physical circulation of materials in September 2023 totaled 46,999 uses;
- Virtual/eResource circulation decreased in November 2023;
 - eResource circulation in November 2023 totaled 36,051 uses;
 - eResource circulation in November 2022 totaled 28,678 uses;
 - eResource circulation in October 2023 totaled 38,047 uses;
 - o eResource circulation in September 2023 totaled 37,388 uses;
- Tempe Public Library staff added 1,051 new cardholders and updated 556 library cards
- Public access computers saw 3,591 sessions in November 2023;
 - The lab on the main floor saw 3,240 uses;
 - The lab in the Teen Center saw 56 uses:
 - The lab in Youth Services saw 209 uses;
 - Satellite locations including the Cahill Senior Center, Escalante Community Center, and the North Tempe Multi-Generational Center saw 86 uses.
 - There is a significant decrease in public access computer use over the past previous months.
 - Code Club will be shifting to grant-funded laptops, which will decrease use on computers in Youth Services
- Tempe Public Library has an average attendance of 1,074 patrons per day.
- The Tempe Public Library App Launch has a total of 1,788 downloads
 - The Library is aiming for 2,000 downloads before 2024
- The Tempe Public Library's newest Youth Librarian, Travis Prillaman, will be starting on Monday, December 12, 2023;
 - T. Prillaman is in a band, so the library will now have two (2) guitar-strumming storytimers.
 - The Support Services Staff has been preparing for the transition to our new automated materials handling and circulation equipment from Bibliotheca;
 - The Library anticipates the transition to begin mid-December and continue through February 2024

- During the transition, staff will be checking in and sorting incoming items manually, but there should be minimal impact on our library users.
- The library is branding 2024 as the "Year of Adventure" since the Summer Reading Program theme is "Adventure Begins at the Library"
- The theme for One Tempe One Book 2024 will be "Death and Dying"
- The Adventure Backpacks are no longer in circulation, since 16 of 24 backpacks were stolen
