Required Materials for Exhibition Application Process:

- Application Form
- Up to 10 digital images of artworks (preferably completed within the last two years) to show level of quality, craftsmanship and innovation of prior work. Work should reflect the “Vital Signs” themes and available for possible display. (JPEG images only, at least 10” in size and 300 dpi minimum). Please label each image with your last name and title of artwork. Example: SmithPurpleSunset.jpg
- Separate image list document with labeled thumbnail images and titles. (PDF or Word doc)
- Short biography statement and an artist statement. (PDF or Word doc)
- Place all submission images and documents in a compressed ZIP folder labeled with your name.

If also applying for the Artist Residency Program, please also include:

- All exhibition application materials.
- Name and contact information for two references who can speak about the quality of your work and your professional reliability. (PDF or Word doc)
- Short letter of interest about the theme and residency opportunity. Include personal and professional goals for growth during the residency. How would this residency challenge you and help you explore new areas? (PDF or Word doc)
- Important: Type “Vital Signs Residency Submission” in subject line of file share.
